

LOCAL 94 EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING MINUTES 10/2/2002

Executive Board members present are Bob Seal (Pres.), Sue Whited (Treasurer), Stacey Madson (Secretary), Bob Knighten (Chief Steward), and Alan Dudziak (at large). Absent was Jay Greenberg (vice president). Bill Lattin (Past President) resigned due to the need to concentrate more fully on his work assignments.

Treasurer's Report by Sue Whited

Checking has \$2397.00 No change in other accounts

Sue presented a bill from the Internet Service Provider for the Local 94 website and internet access. Sue will look in to options and other service providers to compare costs.

Secretary's Report:

Stacey gave a report on union membership and activities since the last meeting. An updated membership list was submitted to IFPTE National as required.

Office Move Grievance

Bob Seal met with management representatives and discussed the recent office moves. Following those discussions, Bob felt convinced that the office moves were conducted correctly and withdrew Local 94 objections to the moves. The affected employees were also satisfied with the end result of the matter.

Local 94 Executive Board discussed a new proposed MOU on office moves that should remove any doubt as to how moves should be conducted. Continuing discussion on that MOU is ongoing.

Motor Pool Issues:

This matter continues to be a thorny issue between management and Local 94. Discussion and negotiations continue.

Other Business:

10 O'Clock News Policy was briefly discussed. Discussion included ethical use of the service (government time, use of government equipment, ID sanctioned and non-sanctioned non-work related news items, etc).

Order 320.1 impacts

Local 94 was invited to have representation in the INEEL Occupational Safety and Health Committee (IOSHC). Local 94 was excluded for a period of time while other unions were represented. Bob Seal was instrumental in gaining Local 94 inclusion again in the charter for IOSHC.
